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FROM THE DIRECTOR

This production began as a chat with my big sister, a 'what if?' musing between two musical theatre lovers as we stacked chairs and locked up one night after a rehearsal. The idea took root, and for the next 3 years – I just couldn't let it go. By making two things true of my JCS universe – that Jesus be female, and a crucial player in an impending election – the world rapidly took shape. This production isn't a commentary on religion or theology; rather, it's using the millennia-old story (as told through now-vintage tunes) to carry an incredibly modern message. Its canvas of familiar lyrics and songs revealed new possibilities, allowing us to mine for new meanings and discover new significance.

As a director, there is nothing more thrilling than watching a long-held vision become fully realised on stage. With the JCS concept there in theory, it took this troupe of dynamic and truly talented performers to bring it to life. Our maestros made sure the notes were hit with the crucial passion and gusto. Our choreographer (the previously fabled big sister) created a movement landscape that continues to dazzle me.

To them all, from an incredibly proud director – thank you. What a joy this has been.



KAELA GRAY DIRECTOR

Kaela has been Artistic Director of Javeenbah Theatre Company since 2018. Previous directing credits include: Playhouse Creatures (Javeenbah Theatre Co.), The Penelopiad (Javeenbah Theatre Co.), Baskerville (Spotlight Theatre Co.), When The Rain Stops Falling (Javeenbah Theatre Co.). Writing credits include: Clutter, for which she won BTG's 2021 One Act Play Festival awards for Best Australian Play, Best Original Work and Best Open Play. 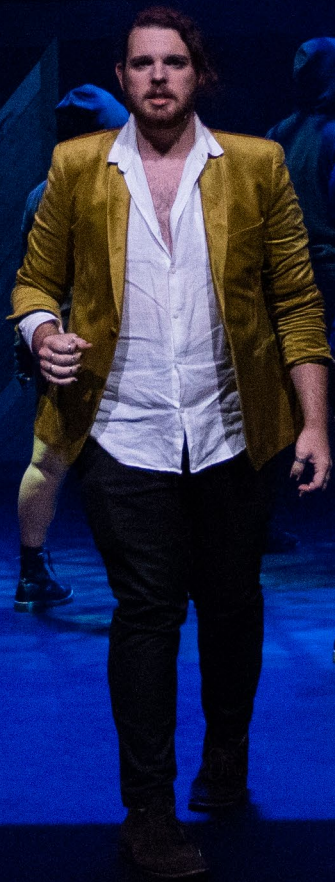
